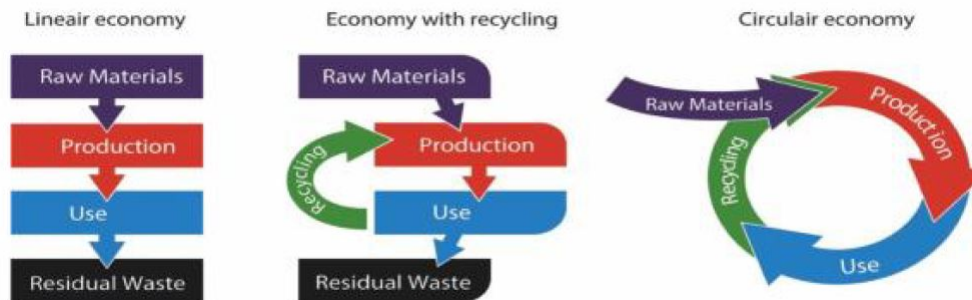

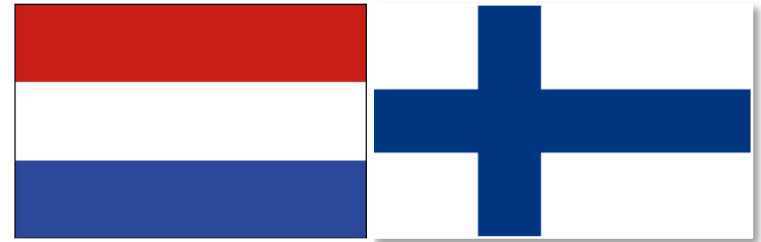
Circular economy in The Netherlands
