Lamy Subira is a Senior Architect in the MASS Kigali Studio, working in Advancement and Business Development capacity leading clients through the early stages of defining the project parameters, establishing impact metrics and the pre-design stages of work. Joining MASS in 2018, Lamy has focused on exploring design as a problem solving tool for various social and environmental challenges and guiding clients through the process of defining their mission.

At MASS, Lamy worked as an Architect on the research, client engagement and design of the Norrsken Kigali Campus, East Africa's biggest Hub for Entrepreneurs funded by the Norrsken Foundation. Prior to Norrsken, he worked as an Associate on the Rwanda Institute for Conservation Agriculture and 14 Trees Affordable Housing; an affordable housing project that responds to a local housing crisis within Kenya and East Africa, providing climate-positive design as the first, and largest, development using 3D-printed building materials at a neighborhood scale in the region.

Currently, Lamy is leading efforts in the Kigali Studio in cultivating projects in Rwanda and the African continent that align with MASS' portfolios in Healthcare, Affordable Housing, Conservation and Cultural & Institutional projects.

Prior to joining MASS, Lamy was an Architect at Studio 4 Architects in Rwanda, working on residential and Educational projects and previously practiced in South Africa as a Senior Architectural Technologist at Boogertman & Partners Architects.
